

Qualifications and Duties of SACC Council Members

President

The President shall be a student enrolled in any programme with good academic standing without any disciplinary records.

The President shall be a student currently enrolled on a program of Level 5 and above and must have completed at least 01 (1) semester of the current programme.

The President shall serve as the official spokesperson for the SACC and represent it in all matters affecting its interests.

The President shall prepare an agenda for the meetings and shall coordinate all the activities of SACC.

The President shall act as the official liaison officer between the College and SACC.

Vice President

The Vice President shall be a student enrolled in any programme with good academic standing without any disciplinary records.

The Vice President shall be a student currently enrolled for a program of Level 5 and above and must have completed at least 01 (one) semester of the current programme.

In the absence of the President, the Vice-President shall act in his/her place and bear all responsibilities.

The Vice President shall be responsible for other SACC duties that the President deem necessary.

Delegates (Non-Executive Members)

The Non-Executive members shall be a student enrolled in the designated courses with good academic standing without any disciplinary records.

Non-Executive members are responsible to the designated batch in promoting the activities of SACC and supporting the executive members in all its activities.

Non-executive members shall consist of;

- One delegate from University Preparation Programme*
- One delegate from Bachelor of Computer Science
- One delegate from Bachelor of Sports and Exercise
- One delegate from Foundation Studies
- One delegate from CIII Programme*
- One delegate from SEGi Programme
- One delegate from CTH Programmes

Important Note:

*The term of the elected programme delegate for the University Preparation Programme and CIII program will be till the end of the current semester. A new member will be elected following the end of term.
